

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING



between

SCHOOL OF HEALTH SCIENCES OF STIKES KEPANJEN MALANG, INDONESIA

and

FACULTY OF NURSING, KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY, THAILAND

Whereas the above named institutions recognize that a Memorandum of Understanding would be of mutual benefit and would serve as an indication of continued interest in academic and scientific cooperation.

To promote international academic cooperation, it is understood that roles and responsibilities of the both parties are that:

- 1. Both parties agree to exchange of:
 - a. materials in education and research, publications, and academic information;
 - b. exchange of undergraduate and graduate students, faculty members officers, and research scholars;
 - c. Joint research activities, meetings for education and research.

Before these activities can be implemented, both parties shall discuss problems involved to the satisfaction of each party and enter into specific activities agreement. Both parties need to support teaching and studying conditions.

- 2. Other collaborative projects will developed under the framework of this Memorandum of Understanding and shall be individually negotiated. Coordinating person from each party should be designated.
- 3. Regarding the cost of exchange activities such as travel costs, subsistence costs, tuition fees, and accommodations should be based on agreement between the two parties.
- 4. This general agreement shall become effective for five (5) years as of the date of signature by the Dean of both parties. The amendment or termination of this general agreement shall not be effected without written deliberation between the two parties.

Both parties will try their best to accommodate the basic rights of their students, faculty members and research scholars within the regulation of the university and the laws of the country.
