



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

FACULTY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, MUHAMMADIYAH UNIVERSITY OF PURWOKERTO, INDONESIA





Whereas the above named institutions recognize that a Memorandum of Understanding would be of mutual benefit and would serve as an indication of continued interest in academic and scientific cooperation, it is understood that:

- 1. Both parties agree to encourage the following activities in particular to promote international academic cooperation:
 - (1) Exchange of materials in education and research, publication and academic information;
 - (2) Exchange of faculty members and research scholars;
 - (3) Human resource development;
 - (4) Joint research activities and meetings for education and research.

Before these activities can be implemented, both parties shall discuss problems involved to the satisfaction of each party and enter into specific activities agreement based on the forms of implementation mutually agreed upon.

- 2. Both parties will keep on pushing forward the mutual training cooperation such as promoting teacher and officer exchange, training experience exchange; supporting teaching and studying conditions.
- 3. Other collaborative projects will be developed under the framework of this Memorandum of Understanding and the terms for such collaborative projects shall be individually negotiated.
- 4. This general agreement shall become effective for five (5) years as of the date of signature by the President of both parties. The amendment or termination of this general agreement shall not be effected without written deliberation between the two parties.

Both parties will try their best to accommodate the basic rights of their faculty members and research scholars within the regulations of the university and the laws of the country.
