

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Khon Kaen University
THAILAND

And

Curators of the University of Missouri
for the
University of Missouri, Columbia

Whereas Khon Kaen University (KKU) and the University of Missouri (MU) recognize that a Memorandum of Understanding would be of mutual benefit and would serve as an indication of continued interest in cooperation, it is understood that:

1. Each institution will encourage the enrollment of qualified students in the other's academic programs. Each student involved in these programs will be subject to the admission requirements and tuition and fees of the host university, or the admission requirements enumerated in supplements to this agreement;
2. Faculty from each institution will collaborate in producing proposals for external funding as appropriate;
3. Faculty from each institution may consult and collaborate to extend and enhance selected degree programs.
 - 1) Initially, MU and KKU agree to collaborate in the development of the DPA program in KKU's College of Local Administration (COLA).
 - a) The MU campus liaison will nominate faculty willing to assist KKU (COLA) as lecturers and DPA student advisors. Nomination materials will include faculty CVs, current research and teaching interests, and availability. These materials will be updated annually or as needed. The MU campus liaison will prepare a brief report on collaboration activities to be provided to the KKU COLA liaison and to the MU Vice Provost for International Programs.
 - b) KKU can invite nominated MU faculty for short-term campus visits as needed, to present lectures, consult with faculty and advise students completing the COLA DPA program.
 - c) MU can invite KKU-COLA faculty for short-term campus visits as needed, to pursue research and/or teaching collaborations.
 - d) All expenses associated with travel and accommodations on short-term campus visits described above will be covered by the host university. Visiting faculty members will receive no additional compensation from the host university.
 - e) KKU and MU will, when appropriate, use digital technologies (such as email, telephone and videoconferencing) to sustain and enhance collaboration on the COLA DPA program.





f) Each institution will appoint a liaison to monitor outcomes and serve as primary points of contact. The MU primary contact will be Prof. Bart Wechsler (wechslerb@missouri.edu). The KCU COLA primary contact will be Peerasit Kamnuansilpa (peerasit@kku.ac.th).


2) Both institutions will explore opportunities for academic collaboration. Specific roles and responsibilities in future collaborations will be formally agreed in ADDENDA to this MOU.

This Memorandum of Understanding will become effective on the final date of signing and be in effect for five years. It can be renewed by mutual consent or terminated by either institution with 90-day written notice.


