UTRECHT UNIVERSITY, THE NETHERLANDS




To continue to promote the advancement of international understanding, academic excellence, dissemination of learning and strengthening cultural ties, the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Khon Kaen University, Thailand and Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Utrecht University, the Netherlands, agree to pursue collaboration on academic and research on the following terms of understanding:

1. The scientific co-operation should be strengthened and broadened by joint assistance.
2. Exchange of faculty members will be encouraged for teaching, research training, post-graduate and post-doctoral studies. Student exchange will also be enhanced.
3. As a general principle, the parties will mutually determine arrangements for payment of costs of co-operative activities undertaken pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding.
4. Each exchange must be approved in advance by the competent authorities of the respective universities.
5. The parties will negotiate research activities in areas of mutual interest. Parties will try to obtain external funding from their respective government and/or international donor funds to support their collaborative research projects.
6. Information and publications in the field of veterinary science and research should be periodically exchanged.
7. This memorandum will become effective upon signature and will be valid for 5 years. The memorandum is to be reviewed within one year prior to the termination and will be extended by mutual accord.

8. The Faculties will take appropriate measures and convene periodic meeting between the appropriate and institutes to : (1) develop a workplan, specifying co-operative programs and projects of common interest as well as the activities to be carried out and funded under this Memorandum during a period of 2 years or otherwise agreed upon; (2) review the implementation of the respective workplan and this Memorandum
