

**AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC EXCHANGE
BETWEEN
FACULTY OF EDUCATION, KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY, KINGDOM OF THAILAND
AND
FACULTY OF HUMAN DEVELOPMENT, UNIVERSITY OF TOYAMA, JAPAN**

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote further friendship and academic exchange between Faculty of Education, Khon Kaen University, Kingdom of Thailand and Faculty of Human Development, University of Toyama, Japan, both parties join in the following agreement in the spirit of mutual reciprocity and equality.

1. Both parties agree to cooperate in the development and implementation of the following:
 - (1) Exchange of academic materials, publications, and information
 - (2) Exchange of scholars and researchers
 - (3) Exchange of students
 - (4) Implementation of cooperative research
 - (5) Organization of academic conferences
 - (6) Other items agreeable to both parties
2. In order to carry out the provision above, a memorandum will be concluded after this Agreement has been signed by both deans.
3. Any change or modification of this Agreement must have mutual discussion and the written consent of both parties.
4. This Agreement will be effective upon the date of signature by the representatives of both parties, and will continue for five (5) years. This Agreement is renewable for five-year increments unless either party elects to terminate it. Either party may terminate this Agreement with or without cause upon sixty (60) days written notice to the other party.
5. This Agreement will be drawn up in English, and either party has the authentic copy.

**MEMORANDUM ON THE ACADEMIC EXCHANGE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC EXCHANGE
BETWEEN
FACULTY OF EDUCATION, KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY, KINGDOM OF THAILAND
AND
FACULTY OF HUMAN DEVELOPMENT, UNIVERSITY OF TOYAMA, JAPAN**

Based on the agreement for academic exchange agreed to by Faculty of Education, Khon Kaen University, Kingdom of Thailand and Faculty of Human Development, University of Toyama, Japan, and guided by the principle of mutual reciprocity, this Memorandum covers the practice of the exchange of scholars, researchers, and the exchange of students as follows.

1. Regarding the exchange of scholars and researchers, the scholars and the researchers who will be sent must be accepted by the host party. Visiting scholars and the researchers are responsible for all expenses including travel to and from both countries, living expenses, and other personal expenses. The host party is expected to make arrangements for participants to use the facilities and so on for their academic pursuits and activities, and to assist participants in locating housing.
2. Regarding the exchange of students, the following conditions are agreed;
 - (1) Exchange students are regarded as non-degree (nontraditional) students (as Tokubetsu Choko Gakusei or Tokubetsu Kenkyu Gakusei at University of Toyama). Credits earned may be transferable according to policies applicable at the home party.
 - (2) Exchange students must meet the minimum entry requirements of the host party. Exchange students are responsible for their own travel expenses to and from both countries and living expenses. Exchange students will pay tuition and academic fees at their respective home party and shall not be required to pay tuition and academic fees at the respective host party. Exchange students will be responsible for paying the costs of room, board, transportation, insurance, textbooks, and other miscellaneous costs.
 - (3) Exchange students must obtain comprehensive medical insurance, including coverage for accidental death or dismemberment, medical evacuation and repatriation as required by the host country's regulations. Documentation of insurance coverage may be submitted before exchange visits are approved or visitors may purchase insurance upon arrival. The host party will be responsible for providing information on necessary medical coverage. Medical emergency costs will be the responsibility of the participant.
 - (4) The relationship of the parties shall be that of independent contractors and neither party shall be deemed nor will hold itself out as being a partner or agent of the other party. Neither party shall be liable for the acts of the other nor the acts of participants in the exchange.

- (5) The length of study abroad program participation may be up to one (1) year.
- (6) The home party may send up to five (5) students in accordance with the academic calendar of the host party per academic year at its discretion in observance of the reciprocity principle.
3. Any change or modification of this Memorandum must have mutual discussion and the written consent.
4. This Memorandum will be effective upon the date of signature, and will continue until the end of the Agreement for Academic Exchange between the parties.
5. This Memorandum will be drawn up in English, and either party has the authentic copy.
