
Griffith Health Group, Griffith University, Australia and the Faculty of Public Health, Khon Kaen University, Thailand (individually a party and collectively parties to this Letter of Intent) believe that:


- 1: Mutual benefit can be derived from scholarly interaction, co-operative research and other forms of academic collaboration.
2. The parties wish to explore the following areas of cooperation, including but not limited to, the fields of Nutrition and Public Health.
 - (i) Collaborative research and international network building;
 - (ii) Training and exchange of post graduate students, postdoctoral researchers, academic and supporting staff;
 - (iii) Mentorship of research scholars;
 - (iv) Joint applications for research grants and research centre funding;
 - (v) Joint publication in academic journals and presentations at seminars and conferences;
 - (vi) Facilitation of arrangements for visitation of academic staff and postgraduate students.
4. Any specific program will be subject to mutual consent, availability of funds and approval of both parties.
5. The parties agree that this Letter of Intent is a statement of intent only and does not constitute a formal legal agreement giving rise to any legal relationship, rights, duties or consequences, but it is only a definite expression and record of the purpose of the parties to which the parties are bound in honour only.
6. This Letter of Intent will be effective when both parties have signed it and shall remain in place for a period of five (5) years unless terminated earlier. Either party may terminate this Letter of Intent by giving the other party six (6) months written notice.
