



AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AND COOPERATION  
BETWEEN  
FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE, KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY, THAILAND  
AND  
GRADUATE SCHOOL OF HORTICULTURE AND  
FACULTY OF HORTICULTURE, CHIBA UNIVERSITY, JAPAN



Faculty of Agriculture, Khon Kaen University, Thailand and Graduate School of Horticulture and Faculty of Horticulture, Chiba University, Japan, with the objective of facilitating mutual friendship, academic research and educational cooperation between the two institutions, hereby conclude this agreement.

Article 1. Faculty of Agriculture, Khon Kaen University and Graduate School of Horticulture and Faculty of Horticulture, Chiba University will cooperate in promoting both academic research and enhancing educational opportunities for students.

Article 2. In order to promote the cooperation prescribed in Article 1, the two institutions may undertake various activities such as those listed below. The details of the collaboration will be specified through separate negotiations.

- (1) The exchange of faculty members and researchers
- (2) The exchange of students
- (3) Organization of joint research projects, including conferences and meetings
- (4) The exchange of information and publications
- (5) Other activities mutually agreed upon by the two institutions.

Article 3. This agreement shall become effective on the date of signature by the representatives of the two institutions, and will be effective for a period of five years. The period of validity may be extended upon mutual agreement of the two institutions.

Article 4. Amendments to this agreement may be made upon mutual agreement of the two institutions.

Article 5. This agreement may be terminated upon six months' written notice by either side.

Article 6. This agreement shall not bind either institution to any financial commitment.

In accordance with Article 2(2) in the Agreement for Academic exchange and Cooperation between Faculty of Agriculture, Khon Kaen University, Thailand, and Graduate School of Horticulture and Faculty of Horticulture Chiba University, Japan, the two universities agree as follows to exchange students.

Article 1. The agreement covers the exchange of undergraduate and graduate students which will occur on a regular basis.

Article 2. Unless otherwise defined, “exchange” shall mean a one-for-one exchange of students from each university; “exchange students” shall mean students participating in the exchange implemented herein; “sending university” shall mean the university at which the student intends to graduate; and “receiving university” shall mean the university that has agreed to receive the exchange students from the sending university.

Article 3. Eligible students for exchange programs will be recommended by the sending university. The receiving university will review the academic records and recommendations of students in a final determination of eligibility for a particular program.

Article 4. It is agreed that both universities under this agreement will accept only students not seeking degrees at the receiving university.

Article 5. Expenses incurred by exchange students in programs under this agreement, except for expenses covered by Article 6 below, will be borne by the individual student.

Article 6. The receiving university will not charge the exchange student for tuition or fees for application and registration.

Article 7. The agreement allows for as many as students to study at the receiving university for a period of up to 12 months on an annual basis. Both universities will review the program annually for any imbalances in the number of exchange students and try to adjust the numbers of students exchanged to maintain a reasonable balance in the exchange. Both universities will endeavor to make the number of the exchange students equal by the end of the agreement.

Article 8. The exchange students must satisfy the language proficiency requirements of their course of studies. The exchange students must have completed at least one year of continuous study at the sending university before being accepted for the exchange. An exchange student who applies to study at the graduate level must have completed at least one semester of graduate studies before being accepted for the exchange. Upon completion of the exchange students must return to the sending university.

Article 9. Each university party to this agreement will recognize the credit awarded by the other university for courses taken and assessed according to the regulations and practices of the sending university.


Article 10. Each university will, within the limits of their resources, assist exchange students covered under the terms of this agreement in securing accommodations and in achieving their study and research goals.

Article 11. This agreement takes effect when it is signed by both parties. The agreement is to remain in effect for five years from the date it is signed. The agreement may be extended when mutually agreeable to both parties.

Article 12. The agreement may be modified by mutual agreement.


Article 13. The agreement may be abolished by either university with notification to the other party six months prior to the effective date of termination.
