


Agreement of Academic Exchange and Cooperation
between
Khon Kaen University, Thailand
and
Tottori University, Japan

The President of Khon Kaen University and the President of Tottori University, with the objective of promoting academic exchange and cooperation in the fields of research between the two universities, here agree to the following:


- 1 . Based upon the principles of respect for each others independence and of mutual benefit, the two universities will engage in the following activities:
 - (1) Exchange of professors, research scholars and staff;
 - (2) Exchange of undergraduate and graduate students;
 - (3) Exchange of scientific data, samples, specimen, and other information;
 - (4) Collaborative activities such as joint research, lectures, symposia, etc;
- 2 . In order to carry out any of the above activities, a detailed plan may be drawn up after consultation between the two universities. Such a plan shall be the result of negotiation between the parties concerned in each specific case. The parties will enter into a written agreement prior to the implementation of a specific activity.
- 3 . This Agreement shall impose no financial obligations on either universities.
- 4 . This Agreement remains effective for a period of five years starting from the latter date of the signing indicated below. Its period of validity may be extended by mutual agreement. Either party may, by giving six months written notice to the other party, terminate this agreement during its period of validity.
- 5 . This Agreement is executed in two identical copies, written in English, and both parties will retain one each copy of this Agreement.

Memorandum for Student Exchange Based on Academic Exchange
between
Khon Kaen University, Thailand
and
Tottori University, Japan

Khon Kaen University and Tottori University can exchange students within the valid period of the Agreement of Academic Exchange and Cooperation under the following conditions:

1. The host university decides the status of the students accepted.
2. The length of stay should be less than twelve months. Any longer stay must be specifically negotiated and approved between the parties.
3. A maximum of five students will be admitted for each year.
4. Each party nominates exchange students appropriate for the purpose of the academic exchange.
5. After considering the specialty and academic records of exchange students, the host university will determine the curriculum.
6. Each university will properly evaluate the research work done by their exchange students. The university that sent students will credit the students based on the evaluation.
7. The host university will waive entrance fee, tuition fee and examination fee.
8. The host university has no financial obligation for living expenses, accommodation, traffic expenses and medical treatment for the exchange students except that both parties exchange Agreement on specific program or admit special treatment.
9. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Memorandum in duplicate by placing their signatures, and each party shall keep each original.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR JOINT PROJECT AND
HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT BETWEEN TOTTORI UNIVERSITY AND
KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") is made and entered into by and between Tottori University and Khon Kaen University (hereinafter referred to as "Khon Kaen University") with regard to basic matters during the implementation period with respect to the implementation of the Global COE Program entitled Advanced Utilization of Fungus/Mushroom Resources for Sustainable Society in Harmony with Nature (hereinafter referred to as "the Project"), which was adopted by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, Japan. The parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

Promotion of Joint Research and Human Resources Development

1. Tottori University and Khon Kaen University shall cooperate with each other in implementing the joint research pertaining to the Project and at the same time strive to develop human resources who can collect, identify and make use of fungus/mushroom genetic resources, thereby contributing to the development of science and technology.

(1) Biodiversity study and collection of genetic resources of fungus/mushroom in the field.

(2) Collection and analysis of microorganisms in traditional fermentation foods produced in Southeast Asia.

2. Regarding the implementation of joint research and human resources development, Tottori University shall bear the necessary costs for the implementation of the project that is agreed between Tottori University and Khon Kaen University. The details for the expenses spent at Khon Kaen University shall be separately agreed upon by both parties hereto.

3. Culture of all fungus/mushrooms genetic resources obtained during the development of this joint project will be kept in duplicate both in Tottori University and Khon Kaen University.

Handling of Intellectual Property Rights

4. Regarding the creation of any inventions, devices, industrial designs, and the registration of the same as a result of the joint research (hereinafter referred to as "the intellectual property rights") during the effective period of this MOU, attribution of patent rights, utility model rights, industrial designs, breeder's rights (hereinafter referred to as "the patent rights, etc.") and know-how developed pertaining to the right to apply for patents, etc., and the intellectual property rights shall be as follows:

The right to apply for patents, etc., patent rights, and know-how pertaining to the intellectual properties jointly conducted by Tottori University and Khon Kaen University

shall be jointly owned by Tottori University and Khon Kaen University, and the ownership share ratio shall be determined after due consultation between Tottori University and Khon Kaen University in consideration of the degree of contribution by Tottori University and Khon Kaen University.

5. When making an application for the patents, etc. with regard to intellectual property jointly owned by Tottori University and Khon Kaen University, both parties shall separately enter into a joint application agreement for each individual case after due consultation.

6. Regarding any technical information except intellectual property arising out of the joint research that can be kept confidential and is of asset value, Tottori University and Khon Kaen University shall immediately designate it in writing as know-how. In this case, the designation of know-how shall be handled as follows:

(1) Regarding the designation of know-how, the period of time during which confidentiality should be maintained shall be determined and clarified after due consultation between Tottori University and Khon Kaen University; and

(2) After the designation of know-how, the period of time during which confidentiality shall be kept may be shortened or extended as necessary after due consultation between Tottori University and Khon Kaen University.

7. Regarding the expenses required for application for patents, etc. and maintenance of rights pertaining to intellectual property that are jointly owned under the provisions of Paragraph 4 or 5, Tottori University and Khon Kaen University shall bear such expenses according to the ownership share ratio of each party in principle.

Implementation of Research Results

8. Implementation of research results set forth in Paragraph 4 thru the preceding paragraph shall be separately determined for each individual case after due consultation between Tottori University and Khon Kaen University.

Installation of Equipment

9. (1) To promote the joint research and development of human resources, Tottori University shall install equipment that the university purchased and owns, as shown in the Exhibit in Khon Kaen University.

(2) Khon Kaen University shall cooperate with Tottori University when the university purchases the equipments.

10. When a researcher from Khon Kaen University uses the equipment in the preceding paragraph to conduct joint research, the consumable goods required for the use of the equipment shall be borne by Khon Kaen University.

11. (1) Khon Kaen University shall select a person responsible for management of the equipments (hereinafter referred to as "the manager") from its staff members and shall report the results to Tottori University.

(2) The manager shall check the delivery of the equipments and report the results to Tottori University. Regarding the equipments that are passed the inspections, the laboratory manager shall send the invoice and delivery slip to Tottori University.

12. Any failure of the equipments installed in Khon Kaen University shall be settled in good faith after due investigation between Tottori University and Khon Kaen University.

Handling of Other Matter of Consultation

13. Any questions concerning any of the provisions stipulated in this MOU or any matters that need to be stipulated in addition to those stipulated in this MOU shall be settled in good faith after due consultation between Tottori University and Khon Kaen University.

14. This MOU shall be effective for a period of time counting from the date of execution of this MOU to March 31, 2013. Provided, however, that in the event either party hereto intends to revise the contents of this MOU or revoke this MOU, the party shall give written proposal to the other party hereto at least three months before the intended date of revision or revocation.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, two copies of this MOU shall be made in English and both parties hereto shall, after signing and affixing seals to these copies, retain one copy each.
