Details for Implementation Of Memorandum of Understanding

The Academic Exchange Agreement between

Faculty of Agriculture, Khon Kaen University (FA-KKU) and

Faculty of Agriculture, University of the Ryukyus (FA-UR)

I. Objective

Within the framework of the Memorandum of Understanding, the Details for Implementation will provide for procedural matters, financial arrangement, and any other matter necessary for the implementation of the Academic Exchange Agreement between Khon Kaen University (KKU) and University of the Ryukyus (UR). To smoothly implement the programs under the Details for Implementation, KKU and UR are agreed to assign, Dean, Faculty of Agriculture, KKU and Dean, Faculty of Agriculture, UR as the Thai Coordinator and Japanese Coordinator, respectively.

II. Fields for Academic Exchange

The fields for academic exchange are as follows:

Agriculture Science, Land Resources and Environmental Science, Animal Science, Plant Science, Plant Protection, Biochemistry, Forestry and Agriculture and Forest Economics.

III. Types of Academic Exchange

The project to be implemented during the period when the Memorandum of Understanding is in effect will be as follows.

1) Exchange of scholars and researchers

The exchange of scholars and researchers will consist of the following two categories:

- (1) Visits by professors who will give lectures or exchange ideas and information in their fields with professors in the receiving country
- (2) Visits by senior scientists who will conduct research, or visits by junior scientists who will conduct research under the supervision of senior scientists.

2) Coordination of joint research and symposia

Priority will be given to joint research projects whose themes have been mutually agreed upon at a Joint Staff Meeting

3) Exchange of data, documents and research materials in fields of mutual interest

Exchange of data, documents, and research materials skill be organized in the field agreed upon at a Joint Staff Meeting

4) Exchange of students

The purpose of the student exchange program is to provide support to students who wish to obtain their degrees or research experiences at FA-KKU and FA-UR.

IV. Financial Arrangement

Financial responsibilities arising out of this Memorandum will be defined and agreed to by the two parties as when specific project initiatives are implemented.
