

Agreement on Academic Co-operation between Faculty of Animal Science, Hue University and Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Khon Kaen University

In order to promote staff and education cooperation, the Faculty of Animal Science, Hue University and the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of Khon Kaen University have reached an agreement on staff and student exchanges between the two institutions. The details of the agreement are described as follows:

1. The student majoring in veterinary medicine, master degree and Ph.D students from both institutes could be sent to either institute for research, practicing in animal hospital and/or study culture and animal industry.
2. To promote the knowledge and experience in teaching and researching on staffs in both institutions, staff exchange could be performed.
3. The period of stay should be discussed individually.
4. As a general principle, arrangements for payment of costs of co-operative activities will be mutually determined by both parties. Parties will try to obtain external funding from their respective government and/or international donor funds to support their collaborative research projects.

The tuition and accommodation fees on the campus of category 1 and 2 are waived by both institutions.
5. The students (and teachers) are responsible for their own travel costs for going to the other institution and returning to their own institution. The students (and teachers) are also responsible for their insurance payments and tourism costs.
6. The agreement shall become effective as of signature by the dean of both parties and shall remain in force for an initial period of five years. Both parties agree that this Agreement should be reviewed approximately every five years in order to evaluate progress and improve the quality of the cooperation.
7. International common practices and laws must be followed should any disputes

occur during the implementation of the agreement.

8. One copy of the agreement is kept by either institution and it is the legitimate documentation that can be used for any legal purposes.


