THE STUDENT EXCHANGE AGREEMENT

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THE STUDENT EXCHANGE AGREEMENT BETWEEN KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY, THAILAND AND SOUTHWEST UNIVERSITY, P. R. CHINA

In order to promote the educational & cultural exchange between Thailand and China, Southwest University of P. R. China (SWU) and Khon Kaen University of Thailand (KKU) agree on student exchange activities under the GENERAL AGREEMENT FOR COOPERATION AND EXCHANGE BETWEEN KKU AND SWU.

1. Student Exchange

1) Number of the exchange students

KKU and SWU will exchange up to 4 undergraduates and/or postgraduates in each academic year. Both universities should try to balance the number of exchange students for each term of exchange.

2) Period of stay

The length of stay for each exchange student could be from about one semester up to one academic year or the equivalent. Normal enrollment will begin in June or November at KKU and in March or September at SWU. Period of stay at other times will be considered upon request of the student.

3) Selection of the exchange students

Each university shall be responsible for the nomination of qualified candidates for the exchange program. KKU should nominate the qualified candidates to SWU no later than the end of August of each academic year, and SWU should nominate the qualified candidates to KKU no later than the end of January of each academic year. The host university will make a final decision to select the exchange students depending on the field of study, space availability, and other related circumstance.

4) Status of the exchange students

The exchange student shall be admitted as an exchange student (non-degree student) in the respective host university for the period of exchange. The exchange student shall receive the full rights of students in the host university and be bound by the rules and regulations of the host university. The basic conditions provided and offered to the exchange student by the host university will not be lower than what their own students have received.

5) Study plan and evaluation

The study program at the host university will be determined for the exchange students in consultation with the academic supervisors of both the host and home universities. Academic performance of the exchange student shall be evaluated according to the regulations of the host university.

6) Credit transfer

Both universities agree to endeavor to transfer credits earned by exchange students at the host university, subject to the regulations and procedures of the home university.

7) Tuition and expenses

The exchange students will pay their tuition fee and accommodation cost, etc. to their own home university where s/he originally comes from. Both universities will mutually waive the tuition fee and provide the free accommodation for the exchange students during the period of exchange. Other expenses including living costs, round trip air tickets, health insurance and visa application fee and so on, will be paid by the exchange students themselves.

2. Internship Program to Practice Chinese Teaching

Upon request by KKU, SWU, with the coordination of the Confucius Institute at KKU, will select the qualified third-year (or higher-year) undergraduates and/or postgraduates who are in specialty of Teaching Chinese as a Foreign Language, literature or related fields to have a six-month or longer term of internship in Chinese teaching at KKU. KKU, as a host institution, will be responsible for the following activities:

- 1) Issuing invitation letter(s)
- 2) Offering free accommodation for each interne
- 3) Providing 6,000 Baht/month of living expenses for the undergraduates and 8,000 Baht/month for the postgraduates
- 4) Health insurance
- 5) Visa extension
- 6) Local transportation to and from the airport
- 7) One way air-ticket (including international and domestic)


Confucius Institute at KKU will provide the periodic supervisions to these interns in order to ensure the quality and standard of teaching.

3. Study Tour Program

Both KKU and SWU agree to organize short-term "Study Tour Program" for students and/or faculty members. The costs for such a program will be discussed and mutually agreed.

This addendum will come into effect from the date when the representatives of both universities sign and date it. It is valid for three years. The uncertain items to this addendum could be further discussed by both sides. The addendum is written in English in duplication, both versions are equally authentic.


