Telethon Institute for Child Health Research, Centre for Child Health Research, University of Western Australia, Perth, Western Australia and Faculty of Associated Medical Sciences, Kohn Kaen University, Thailand hereby enter into this agreement to foster international co-operation in education and research.

1. Both parties agree to encourage the following activities in particular to promote international academic co-operation as follows:
 - (i) Exchange of faculty members and research scholars;
 - (ii) Exchange of students
 - (iii) Joint research activities and meetings for education and research
 - (iv) Exchange of materials and technologies in education and research, publications and academic information
 - (v) Co-operation in teaching of graduate curricula

These activities will be focused on special topics as follows:

- (i) Biomedical Sciences
 - (ii) Immunology, molecular biology, biochemistry, infectious and tropical diseases
 - (iii) Genetics and genomics of infectious disease and type 2 diabetes
2. This agreement shall be effective as of the date of signature by both parties. The amendment or the termination of this agreement shall not be effected without deliberation between the two parties.
3. The Institute and Faculty acknowledge that in the absence of any specific agreement to the contrary, all expenses of salary, travel, living and allied costs will be determined at the discretion and be the responsibility of the visitor's home university.
4. Both parties agree that this agreement should be reviewed approximately every five (5) years in order to evaluate progress and improve the quality of the exchange.
