

**AGREEMENT ON ACADEMIC COLLABORATION  
BETWEEN  
FACULTY OF PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES  
KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY, KINGDOM OF THAILAND  
AND  
INSTITUTE OF NATURAL MEDICINE  
UNIVERSITY OF TOYAMA, JAPAN**

The purpose of the Agreement is to develop and carry out collaborative activities of common interest between Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Khon Kaen University and Institute of Natural Medicine, University of Toyama as set forth in the following.

**Clause 1**

Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Khon Kaen University and Institute of Natural Medicine, University of Toyama (hereinafter referred to as parties) agree to establish and develop collaborative activities of common interest in areas respected to academics, research, and knowledge transferring in the fields related to pharmaceutical and medical sciences.

**Clause 2**

The following academic collaborations between both parties include:

- 2.1 Research activities in the areas of mutual interest to both parties.
- 2.2 Exchange of academic methods and materials which are made available by both parties.
- 2.3 Exchange of scholars for furtherance of research and/or teaching collaboration or supports.
- 2.4 Exchange of undergraduate and graduate students as well as postdoctoral scholars for furtherance of their cultural, scholar and professional development.
- 2.5 Promotion of cooperative seminars, workshops and other academic meetings on the matters of mutual interest
- 2.6 Joint research of Thai traditional medicines/herbal plants in compliance with the Convention on Biological Diversity and its Nagoya Protocol

**Clause 3**

Details of this cooperation will be specified for each individual activity based on agreement between both parties. This can be documented in separate memorandum between both parties. Regarding points mentioned in Clause 1, interdepartmental/interdivision

memorandums can be made between interested parties at the discretion of department/division chairs and their subordinate committees.

The final approval of any project will be dependent upon the availability of guaranteed supporting funds.

Financial support for each program shall be pursued through mutual efforts of both parties or through discussion and agreement of both parties.


#### Clause 4

This agreement will be valid and effective for a period of five years commencing from the date of its joint signing by the representatives of the two parties. On completion of such period, the agreement shall be re-considered for possible extension.

Each party must give a 6-month advance notice to another party if any amendments to this agreement need to be made.

This agreement shall be written in English and is regarded as the original.
