



**ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
FACULTY OF PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES, KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY
AND
FACULTY OF PHARMACY, MUSASHINO UNIVERSITY**

This agreement is intended to encourage and facilitate academic interchange between the Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Khon Kaen University, THAILAND and Faculty of Pharmacy, Musashino University, JAPAN hereby agree to formally establish academic collaboration in the provision of links in mutually compatible subject disciplines for the purpose of increasing educational exchanges and research collaborations.

General Aspects

Collaboration will initially take the form of assistance in establishing appropriate mechanisms to facilitate placements/exchanges for students and staff. While this will be the main area for agreement, the development of other initiatives is not precluded.

Term of the Agreements

This agreement shall be effective on the date of its signing by the representatives of the two institutions. It will remain in effect for a period of five years from the date of its inception. It may be altered by the mutual consent of the two institutions. It is further understood that it may be cancelled at any time by either party with a six months' notice to the partner party.

Revision and Termination of the Agreement

Both institutions must send a written notice and consult each other at least one year before the revision or termination, when they wish to revise or terminate the agreement.

Placements/Exchange Issues of Students and Staff

1. A placement/exchange student shall be considered to be a student of the partner institution during the period of the partner institution and be subject to the same regulatory and disciplinary provisions as the students of the partner institution.
2. All students moving between the two institutions will be given full academic recognition by their home institution for work successfully completed during their study abroad.
3. Prior to the placement/exchange, members of staff responsible will confirm in writing the names of participating students specifying their academic level and the period of placement/exchange.

4. The partner institution will, when at all possible, assist incoming students in securing suitable accommodations and in orientating to the new environment.
5. Participant in placements/exchanges abroad should be advised to subscribe to a comprehensive health insurance plan.


Financial Agreements
