1. Parties to Collaboration

- I. IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

2. PhD Program Development


- I. To develop cooperation in the staff of Party A to achieve the PhD Program in Research and Development of Pharmaceutical Sciences in KKU.
- II. The PhD Program must comply with KKU's quality control procedures.
- III. The students must attend seminars and pass the qualify examination during the first-18th months. Then, they can do their research in China under the supervision of nominated co-advisor from GTCM by KKU and KKU advisor. The presentation of their dissertations can be performed in both Universities.
- IV. Party B agrees to engage qualified GTCM professors to be co-advisors.
- V. KKU will consider to reduce the tuition fee according to the site of research performance of each student.

3. This agreement has two originals in English. Each party holds one copy. The agreement will take effects after being signed by both parties. Anything excluded from this agreement shall be discussed and negotiated by both parties.



1. Parties to Collaboration

- I. 2. The Sino-Thai Natural Herbs Research

- I. To establish a natural herbs research in both parties for some Sino-Thai research projects.
- II. To send experts to participate in the relative academic conferences and to do academic exchanges.
- III. To exchange the latest research achievements in natural herbs.
- IV. Source of fund

The international traveling fees are supported by the government of each country and their own schools respectively, while the food, accommodation and transportation fee of the visiting scholars and delegations will be paid by both parties through negotiation. Both parties will fund the research programs.

V. Visiting Plans


- i. Cooperative research plans will be worked out after the project is decided, and the research team will be sent to do the investigation of the project and work out the detailed concrete responsibilities.

VI. Research achievement




