



**Letter of Intent III**

**1. Parties to Collaboration**

- I. This agreement sets out the arrangements for collaboration between Guangxi Traditional Chinese Medical (GTCM) University or Party A and Khon Kaen University (KKU) or Party B in the provision of links in mutually benefits for the aim to establish academic links to support and enhance research in Pharmaceutical Sciences.

**IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:**

**2. The Workshop of the Sino-Thai Folk Medicine and Natural Herbs Research**

In order to promote and develop the academic exchange and cooperation in Sino-Thai folk medicine and natural herbs research between Party A and Party B, and to serve for human health, both parties would like to jointly hold the workshop of Sino-Thai folk medicine and natural herbs research. With friendly negotiation, Party A and Party B come to the following agreement:

- I. To exchange and demonstrate the research achievements and experience of the Sino-Thai folk medicine;
- II. To exchange and demonstrate the new techniques, methods, developments and achievements of the natural herbs.
- III. Time, place and the sponsor of the workshop:

The First Sino-Thailand Folk Medicine and Natural Herbs Research Workshop will be held in October 2006 at Guangxi, Nanning, covered the area of herbal research in antiviral, anticancer and anti-aging. This workshop will be held once a year and will be sponsored by the two parties alternately.

**IV. Fund-raising for the workshop:**

- i. Every participant will be required to pay certain amount of registration fee.
- ii. Both parties will try to get financial support from medical or pharmaceutical companies or enterprises.
- iii. The sponsor side will provide with appropriate subsidy.

**V. The preparation of the workshop:**


- i. A Committee will be co-established by both parties for the Sino-Thai workshop with two sections, the secretariat and the staff section, which will be responsible for organizing and preparing for the workshop.

- ii. The Committee will be set up respectively in the Science and Technology Department of Party A and in the Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences of Party B.
  - iii. In the name of the Sino-Thai Workshop Committee, the sponsor side will send the notice of the workshop to those who are interested in this workshop. Both parties will mobilize and organize participants with all possible ways including the assistance with all the correlative procedures required for attending the workshop.
3. This agreement has two originals in English. Each party holds one copy. The agreement will take effects after being signed by both parties. Anything excluded from this agreement shall be discussed and negotiated by both parties.


