# **AGREEMENT OF COOPERATION**

**BETWEEN**

**THE COLLEGE OF LOCAL ADMINISTRATION**

**KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY**

**KHON KAEN, THAILAND**

**AND**

**THE SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT**

**LANZHOU UNIVERSITY**

**GANSU, CHINA**

**Nov. 18, 2015**

With effect from November 18<sup>th</sup>, 2015, the College of Local Administration, Khon Kaen University (COLA), and the School of Management, Lanzhou University (LUSM), hereby agree to explore opportunities to promote academic collaboration between both sides, with particular emphasis on faculty and student exchange, joint conference, joint research, and other agree-upon areas. The signatories of this Agreement establish the following:

## **PART I**

### **SCOPE OF THE COOPERATION**

The areas of potential cooperation include, subject to mutual consent, programs offered at either institutions as felt desirable and feasible on either side, or that both sides contribute to fostering and development of the co-operative relationships between two institutions.

The assistance to be provided by each of the parties will be teaching, research, exchange of faculty and students, cultural exchange and staff development, as deemed beneficiary by the two institutions.

## **PART II**

### **GENERAL AREAS OF COOPERATION**

Each institution, subject to its own approval processes, will be

responsible for providing support for the area of:

- Exchange of faculty;
- Exchange of students;
- Cooperation in research and practice in the field of government performance management and leadership, or any topics related to local governance;
- Joint sponsorship and conduction of International Conferences on issues of mutual benefit including Government Performance Management and leadership;
- Promotion of programs in each own institution for programs in the other sides.

The resources required for each activity shall be discussed and agreed upon at a later stage in writing by both parties in the form of Memorandum of Understanding prior to the initiation of the activity. The Memorandum of Understanding will also outline the timescale and identify appropriate staffing.

### **PART III**

#### **TERM, RENEWAL, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT**


This Agreement shall remain for a period of five (5) years from the effective date noted above. This Agreement may be terminated by

either party at any time with a minimum of ninety (90) days written notice. Such termination shall be in writing but shall not affect the implementation and execution of projects or programs already established under this agreement prior to such termination.

The provisions of this agreement may be amended in writing at any time at the request of either party and will take effect upon signature by both parties. Any such amendment may not extend the length of this Agreement beyond the original five-year term. Any amendment will become part of this Agreement when executed.
