



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON COOPERATION OF ART AND CULTURE BETWEEN KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY,

THE KINGDOM OF THAILAND

AND

NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF ARTS AND CULTURE, YANGON, MINISTRY OF RELIGIOUS AFFAIRS AND CULTURE, THE REPUBLIC OF THE UNION OF MYANMAR

This Memorandum of understanding has been signed at National University of Arts and Culture, Yangon, The Republic of The Union of Myanmar, by and between, Faculty of Fine and Applied Arts, Khon Kaen University, Thailand of one part and National University of Arts and Culture (Yangon) (NUAC), Ministry of Religious Affairs and Culture, The Republic of The Union of Myanmar of the other part. These parties are desirous in promotion of educational affairs and establishment of understanding in art and culture and friendship among the parties in the future as follow.

Article 1

Two institutes agree to undertake within the framework of the regulations applying in each of the institute, subject to the availability of resources as follows:

- Launching of joint workshop in Visual Arts and Performing Arts including exhibition, research, art creation activities, and research personnel;
- b. Exchange of faculty members and exchange of students;
- c. Organizing joint conference, seminar, workshop, exhibition, academic meeting and academic journal;
- d. Cultural activities;
- e. Other educational and scientific research activities.

Article 2

After the execution of this MoU, two institutes will sign cooperation and exchange agreement in accordance with further cooperation and exchange activities. In case of a matter of dispute, that can be solved peacefully in coordination and negotiation by the representatives of two institutes.

Article 3

This MoU will be affected when it is signed by both parties and shall continue in effect for a period of 5 years from that date. The MoU will be renewed automatically unless a written request for its termination is submitted to the other university 6 months in advance.

Article 4

Signed in duplicate at the National of Arts and Culture, Yangon, on 9th December 2016 in two originals in English language with seals and signatures of representatives of two institutes and each institute will keep one of the two original copies.
