## Memorandum of Understanding between **EDENZ Colleges, Auckland, New Zealand**

## THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE THAT;

- 1. The College of Local Administration will provide help, guidance and support to EDENZ Colleges to establish an English Language Training Centre at the College of Local Administration on the campus of Khon Kaen University. The purpose of this centre is to
  - a. Provide English language training to KKU students identified by COLA
  - b. Provide English language training to other students in the region, as identified by COLA.
  - c. Provide other training courses from time to time, as identified by COLA as meeting a local need.
  - d. Promote EDENZ as a study destination for students wanting to study abroad.
- 2. EDENZ Colleges will plan appropriate curricula, determine appropriate resources, and arrange appropriately qualified staff to manage the centre, and deliver such courses, to a mutually agreed level of quality.
- 3. The specific terms and conditions of the project will be negotiated between the two institutions before the start of the project, and may include, but are not limited to
  - a. Division of costs and income, and other financial issues
  - b. Provision of facilities, materials and resources
  - c. Legal and regulatory issues such as Work Permits
- 4. The underlying principle of this Memorandum of Understanding, and any consequent specific agreement, is reciprocity.
- 5. Both parties agree to use their best endeavours to fulfill the intent of this Memorandum of Understanding, and to begin the project as soon as practicable.
