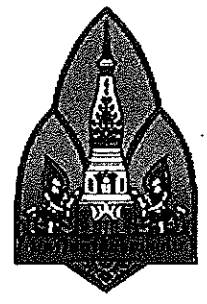

Recalling the need for effective cooperation in promotion of education, training and research that will benefit both parties,

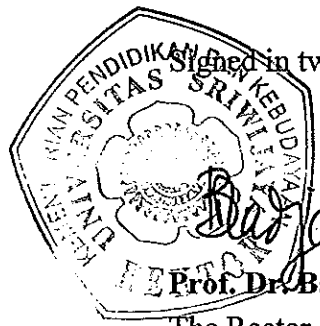
Recognizing the importance of education, training and research to develop human resources and institutional strengthening of both parties,

Have agreed to develop possibilities for cooperation in the field of:

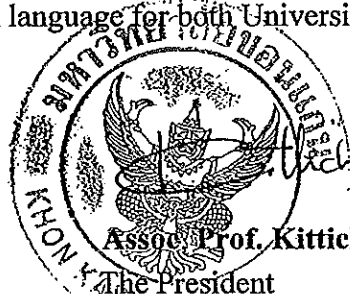
- a. Development of educational program;

This MoU shall be effective upon signature and be valid for an initial period of five years, to be extended through amendment by mutual agreement of the parties.

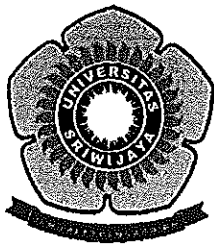

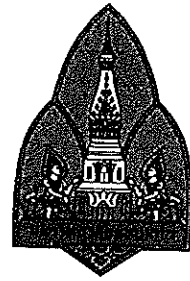

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT



**BETWEEN
THE FACULTY OF SOCIAL AND POLITICAL SCIENCES
SRIWIJAYA UNIVERSITY**

COLLEGE OF LOCAL ADMINISTRATION, KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY**

Faculty of Social And Political Sciences, Sriwijaya University (FSPS-UNSRI) represented by the Dean, Dra. Dyah Hapsari, ENH, M.Si and College of Local Administration, Khon Kaen University (COLA, KCU) represented by the Dean, Supawatanakorn Wongthanavas, Ph.D. hereinafter referred to as the "Parties."

Therefore, the two Parties are committed to strengthen and develop their cooperation in research and education and agree to establish a program for academic cooperation in areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Sriwijaya University and College of Local Administration, Khon Kaen University. The two institutions agree as follows:

1. GENERAL AREA OF CO-OPERATION

1.1. Both Parties agree that cooperation shall be carried out through such activities of programs

relating to education, training, research and any other fields related.

1.2. Both Parties agree that programs and activity enumerated are not exclusive and the parties may agree to include such other programs and activities as may be necessary and identified later which shall be mutually discussed and agree upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of the particular program or activity and such shall be negotiated as required.

1.3. Both Parties, within their capacities will cooperate to promote and develop programs in technological education.

1.4. Both Parties shall each designate a coordinator to manage the program activities. Each party shall nominate and appoint a coordinator from its staff to coordinate activities and facilitate the development of such joint activities.

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE COOPERATION

The parties consider common interest to promote and encourage collaborative activities in education, training, research and any other fields related to development of education that will benefit both parties, Recognizing the importance of education, training and research to develop human resources and institutional strengthening of both parties.

3. SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

Both Parties agree and acknowledge that collaboration may develop in the following program but not limited to:

- a. Developing the curriculum and courseware sharing
- b. Activities of staffs exchange include participation as visiting scholars or lecturers, professor, scholars-in-residence, study tour, visiting speakers, and any other programs.
- c. Activities of students exchange include study tour, courses attendance and research, transfer credit, workshops, conference and other programs.
- d. Joint Research and Development (R&D) subject to approval of both parties.
- e. Joint Conferences, workshops, publication, journal and short-term courses.

4. COST AND EXPENSES

All expenses required for this Cooperation will be covered professionally and proportionally which will be provided by ALL PARTIES based on the available funds and the respective responsibilities of THE PARTIES according to the working plan to be agreed. For students and staffs exchange, all expenses for the activities will be covered by their own Parties, The detail of each contribution regarding this cooperation shall be made in writing and agreed by both parties and shall be negotiated to the mutual acceptance of both parties.

5. OWNERSHIP

Ownership on whatever products of studies/research shall belong to both parties signatory of this Memorandum and no publication of the products of study of research is allowed to publish without the consent of both parties.

6. DURATION AND TERMINATION

- a. This Memorandum shall enter into force at the day of signature by the signatory of each party and shall remain in force for 5 (five) years unless terminated by one of the parties giving three (3) months notice to the other.
- b. This Memorandum shall be reviewed at the end of two (2) years to determine the effectiveness to continue or terminate
- c. Where such termination occurs, the provision of this Memorandum shall continue to apply to on-going activities until their completion.

7. RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE TWO PARTIES

No parts of this Memorandum are to be interpreted as to allow any other cooperation or business organization to register on behalf of the two parties or appoint one of the parties as the agent of the other party.

8. CONFIDENTIALITY

All information and or data that may be exchanged, acquired and shared in connection with the area of cooperation between FSPS-UNSRI and COLA, KKKU pursuant to this memorandum shall be treated strictly confidential and shall not under any circumstances be divulged by the receiving party unless otherwise the same has already been in public domain.

9. GOVERNING LAW

This Memorandum of Agreement shall be applied in accordance with the laws and regulations in force in the territory of each cooperating party, in respect of activities taking place in the party's territory.

10. NOTICES

Any notices, approval, application or any form of communication that is required to be given by any parties under this Memorandum shall be in writing and shall be deemed to be sufficiently served:


- a. In the case of delivery by hand, on the day of delivery.
- b. In the case of delivery by post (prepared post), on the 7th (seventh) business day after posting.
- c. In the case of communication by facsimile, on the sender receipt of transmission report which purports to confirm that the addressee has received such facsimile.

11. AMENDMENTS



