



DEVELOPMENT OF COLLABORATIVE EDUCATION AND RESEARCH PROGRAMS

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN:

SAINT LOUIS UNIVERSITY AND KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY

This Memorandum of Agreement for the Development of Collaborative Education Programs (the "MOA") is made and entered into on this, the 2nd day of June, 2017, by and between Saint Louis University, an institution of higher education and research located in St. Louis, Missouri, U.S.A, for its School of Education ("SLU"), and Khon Kaen University, an institution of higher education and research located in Khon Kaen, Thailand, for its Faculty of Education ("KKU").

SLU and KKU wish to promote greater international understanding and to enhance education and research opportunities for their students, faculties, and staff. The parties hereby agree to mutually support efforts aimed at exploring the development of possible collaborative education programs and research efforts with particular focus on the types of programs contemplated by the parties under this MOA (each referred to herein as a "program", and collectively as "programs").

1. PURPOSE & LEGAL EFFECT

- 1.1 Purpose. The parties understand and agree that the purpose of this MOA is to set forth the terms and guidelines upon which the parties shall mutually explore the development of programs in the U.S. and Thailand, as well as certain terms and conditions that the parties consider material to the creation and administration of a program.
- 1.2 Legal Effect. The parties understand and agree, that except as otherwise expressly stated in this MOA, the provisions contained herein do not give rise to any legally binding commitment nor do they constitute an offer to enter into a legally binding commitment to establish any program, or to provide financial or any other resources for the purpose exploring development of any program that might be contemplated under this MOA. The parties further agree that they shall not commence with the implementation of any educational or research program except in accordance with the terms and conditions of a prior written agreement that is specific to the program the parties seek to implement. Agreements between the parties governing collaborative educational and research programs shall contain terms governing the parties' commitments of financial and other resources, the administration of the program and, where appropriate, publishing goals, technology transfers, sharing research data and intellectual property and the ownership thereof.

2. EFFECTIVE PERIOD & TERMINATION

- 2.1 Effective Period. This MOA shall be effective for a period of [3] years commencing from the date first written above (the "Effective Period"). The Effective Period of this MOA may only be extended by a written agreement of the parties signed by a duly authorized representative of each party.
- 2.2 Termination. Either party may terminate this MOA upon [90] days advance written notice to the other party of its intent to terminate.

3. STUDENT PROGRAMS

- 3.1 Exchange Programs. The parties will explore the development of student exchange -programs.
- 3.2 Student Travel Obligations. Students of either party who wish to participate in a student exchange program or wish to participate in any other program that may be established by the
