

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**  
**FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF ACADEMIC COOPERATION**

**Between**

**CURTIN UNIVERSITY**  
**Perth, Western Australia**

**And**

**KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY,**  
**THAILAND**

In furtherance of their mutual interests in the field of education and as a contribution to increased international cooperation, Curtin University and Khon Kaen University (KKU), have agreed that:

1. The two institutions will:
  - i) cooperate in the exchange of information relating to their scholarly and research activities in fields of mutual interests subject to confidentiality requirements of each Party;
  - ii) promote appropriate joint scholarly activities and research activities, with particular emphasis on internationally funded projects;
  - iii) endeavour to encourage students and staff to spend periods of time in the host institution. The exchange of students will be dependent upon the execution of a formal Student Exchange Agreement mutually agreed between the parties in writing prior to commencement of this activity;
  - iv) conduct cultural projects, as mutually agreed in writing between the parties, prior to commencement of this activity;
  - v) conduct study tours, as mutually agreed in writing between the parties, prior to the commencement of this activity; and
  - vi) provide Study Abroad opportunities at undergraduate and graduate level as mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to the commencement of this activity.
2. The aim of the Memorandum of Understanding shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both Institutions.
3. This Memorandum of Understanding does not transfer any interest in or rights to intellectual property of any party.
4. The coordinators from the two institutions will prepare an annual joint report on activities in the areas of cooperation under this Memorandum of Understanding.
5. In the implementation of specific cooperative programs and research projects, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects including funding, intellectual property, risk allocation, and the obligations to be undertaken by each party will be negotiated, mutually agreed and formalised in writing, prior to the commencement of the program.

6. Any intellectual property developed under this collaboration, which is not subject to an individual written agreement, shall be owned jointly by the Parties as tenants in common where each Party grants the other an irrevocable, worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use the intellectual property for their own internal, non-commercial, research purposes.
7. Each party undertakes to respect the confidentiality of the other party's confidential information. Each party is to treat all confidential information owned by the other party which is specifically designated as confidential information in writing to the other party in advance as confidential, and shall not disclose or permit the same to be disclosed to the third party without the written authorisation of the owner of that confidential information.
8. This Memorandum of Understanding will take effect from the date of its signing and shall be valid for a period of five years from that date unless sooner terminated, revoked or modified by mutual written agreement between the parties, and may be extended by mutual written agreement.

Either party may terminate the Memorandum of Understanding at any time during the term by the provision of three months written notice to the other party.


