

## Agreement for Academic Exchange and Cooperation between

### Wakayama Medical University, Wakayama, Japan and





Wakayama Medical University, JAPAN, and the Faculty of Medicine, Khon Kaen University, THAILAND, hereinafter referred to as 'the two Universities', fully recognizing the benefits of academic exchange and cooperation between the two Universities, hereby confirm their desire to engage in the following activities:

- To exchange academic staff and researchers; and,
- To exchange students.

The aforementioned activities shall be realized by means of consultation and exchange of relevant information between the appropriate members of the two Universities. agreement shall become effective upon signing by the official representatives of the two Universities and shall remain valid for a period of five (5) years. The Agreement may be renewed for a further period of five (5) years by mutual consent prior to the expiry of the original. This Agreement may be amended by mutual agreement of the two Universities. This Agreement shall be prepared in duplicate (2 originals), in English, to be kept one at each school.

# Details of the Agreement for Elective Exchange Student between



## Wakayama Medical University, Wakayama, Japan and

the Faculty of Medicine, Khon Kaen University, Thailand

Wakayama Medical University, JAPAN, and the Faculty of Medicine, Khon Kaen University, THAILAND, hereby agree to undertake a student exchange program.

The following sets forth the guidelines whereby this exchange program shall be implemented within the framework of the Agreement for Academic Exchange and Cooperation between the two Universities:

- 1. The purpose of this exchange program is to provide selected students from the two Universities with occasion to gain overseas experience at the host University, thereby developing goodwill and mutual understanding between the two countries. The elective course-work done overseas will be granted credit at their Home University.
- 2. Normally, the period of this elective exchange student program shall be between four (4) and six (6) weeks.
- 3. The number of exchange students for the initiation period shall be up to four (4) per year from each University.
- 4. Each University will determine the terms and procedures for selecting then accepting the exchange students. Exchange students must satisfy formal admission requirements of the Host University.
- 5. The Host University shall provide the Home University with performance information on each student upon completion of the program.
- 6. The exchange students shall be exempted from any application, registration or tuition fees at the Host University.
- 7. The exchange students are responsible for their accommodation costs albeit the Host University will provide information on accommodations available during the period of the program.
- 8. The exchange program shall commence in academic year 2010 and continue until 2014.

### 9. The Program Directors are:

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
