



ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
COLLEGE OF PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES,
SOUTHWEST UNIVERSITY, CHINA
AND
FACULTY OF PHARMACEUTICAL SCIENCES, KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY,
KINGDOM OF THAILAND

This agreement is intended to encourage and facilitate academic interchange between the College of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Southwest University, China (hereinafter referred to as Institution A) and the Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences, Khon Kaen University, Kingdom of Thailand (hereinafter referred to as Institution B). The two institutions hereby agree to formally establish academic collaboration in the provision of links in mutually compatible subject disciplines for the purpose of increasing educational exchanges and research collaborations.

Placements/Exchange Issues of Students and Staff

1. A placement/exchange student shall be considered as a student of the host institution and be subject to the same regulatory and disciplinary provisions as the students of the host institution.
2. All students moving between the two institutions will be given full academic recognition by their home institution for work successfully completed during their study in the host institution.
3. Prior to the placement/exchange, responsible staff of the home institution will confirm in writing to the host institution the names of participating students specifying their academic level and the period of placement/exchange.
4. The host institution will, when at all possible, assist incoming staff/students in securing suitable accommodations and in orientating to the new environment.
5. Participant in placements/exchanges abroad should be advised to subscribe to a comprehensive health insurance plan.

Scientific Research Cooperation

1. Research cooperation and development of traditional Chinese medicine and Thai medicine
Institution A and B will collaborate in research for traditional Chinese medicine and Thai medicine. Both institutions should promote the international scientific research cooperation projects.

2. Academic seminar

During the cooperation, Institution A and B jointly hold annual international symposiums on natural medicine or new drug research.

3. Exchange of faculty members and research scholars

Both institutions can invite professors and experts to give lectures and professional consultations.

Terms of the Agreement

1. Any disputes arising from or in connection with the agreement shall be settled through mutual consultation and friendly negotiation. In case no settlement can be reached, the International common practices and laws must be followed.
2. This agreement shall be written in English and Chinese, and both versions are in duplicate. Each institution keeps one English and Chinese version and is regarded as the original.
3. This agreement shall become effective on the date of the last signature of the representatives of the two institutions, and will remain in effect for a period of five years.
4. With mutual consent, this agreement may be altered, revised or terminated at any time by either party with a six months' notice to the partner institution. Termination of the agreement shall not affect the program in process till the completion of the program.
