



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

FACULTY OF MEDICINE, LAMBUNG MANGKURAT UNIVERSITY SOUTH KALIMANTAN, INDONESIA

AND

FACULTY OF NURSING, KHON KAEN UNIVERSITY, KHON KAEN, THAILAND

Whereas the above named institutions recognize that a Memorandum of Understanding would be of natural benefit and would serve as an indication of continued interest in academic and scientific cooperation, it is understood that:

- 1. Both parties agree to encourage the following activities to promote international academic cooperation:
 - a. Exchange of materials in education and research, publication and academic information;
 - b. Exchange of faculty members and research/ staff scholars;
 - c. Exchange of students;
 - d. Joint research activities and meetings for education and research.

Before these activities can be implemented, both parties shall discuss problems on the forms of implementation until mutual agreement is reached.

- 2. Tuition fees for students will be set on a case by case basis by the host institution which will endeavor to keep expenses as low as possible.
- 3. Both parties undertake to promote graduate certificate courses, Bachelor's, Master's and /or PhDs and any other relevant programs. Each Party to this MOU will be responsible for the nomination and support of their own visiting scholars, academic staff and students.
- 4. Other collaborative projects will be developed under the framework of this Memorandum of Understanding and the terms for such collaborative projects shall be individually negotiated.
- 5. This general agreement shall become effective for five (5) years as of the date of signature by the President of both parties. Amendment or termination of this general agreement shall not be effected without written deliberation between the two parties.

Both parties will endeavor to provide for the basic rights of their students, faculty members and research scholars.

Memorandum of Agreement On the Academic Exchange Program Between

Faculty of Nursing, Khon Kaen University, Thailand, and Faculty of Medicine, Lambung Mangkurat University, Indonesia

Based on MoU between Faculty of Nursing Khon Kaen University (FoN-KKU) and Faculty of Medicine Lambung Mangkurat University dated July 2017, both parties recognize the benefits of strong international links. To achieve this aim we propose the following agreement:

- 1. The purpose of this agreement is to develop academic and educational collaboration and to promote a joint relationship between the FoN-KKU and Faculty of Medicine Lambung Mangkurat University.
- 2. Both institutions undertake to promote and develop cooperation in the following ways, on a basis of equality and reciprocity:
 - a. Exchange of teaching staff (lecturers)
 - b. Exchange of researchers
 - c. Exchange of students
 - d. Exchange of academic information and publication
 - e. Conducting reciprocal lectures and seminars
 - f. Cooperating in research and the publication of its results
 - g. Identifying other mutually agreed opportunities for collaboration
- 3. To implement these forms of cooperation, representative of our individual institute/faculty will be encouraged to consult with each other and to develop specific plans for collaboration in any or all of the ways outlined in agreement two above.
- 4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of cooperation stated in agreement two above shall depend on our mutual availability of resources and financial support from our respective institutes as listed in ANNEX 1.
- 5. This agreement will come into effect on the date when the representatives of both parties sign the agreement and will remain valid for period of five years. The agreement may be extended after discussion with representatives of both parties. Such discussion needs to commence not later than six months before the termination of agreement.
- 6. The agreement may be revised or modified within that period by mutual consent. Similarly, the agreement may be terminated within the period by either party providing six months notice is given to the other.
- 7. An evaluation will be conducted by FoN-KKU and Faculty of Medicine Lambung Mangkurat University after two years of implementation of this MoA and changes adopted by mutual agreement.

ANNEX 1: Number of Participants

The number of exchanged students, lecturers and researchers can be arranged as follows;

- a. A maximum of 4 students will be exchanged between institutions for each semester
- b. A maximum of 1 lectuter will be exchanged between institutions for each semester
- c. A maximum of 2 researchers/ staff will be exchanged between institutions for each semester

ANNEX 2: Financial Arrangement

Both institutions agree to finance the academic exchange program based on the following arrangements:

- a. Visa, expenditure, and plane ticket international and domestic arrangements shall be responsibility of the home institution
- b. The period of exchange will be for three months maximum
- c. Accommodation for students/lecturers/researchers who participate in the exchange program is to be facilitated by host institution
- d. Accommodation and local transportation is to be provided by the host institution at no cost to participants
- e. Living expenses such as meals and telephone cost shall be the responsibility of the home institution
