This Memorandum of Agreement for international cooperation education, research and community services is entered into by and between the Faculty of Nursing, Khon Kaen University, Thailand, and Faculty of Nursing, University of Jember, Indonesia.

BACKGROUND

WHEREAS, the parties believe that it is in their best interests to encourage direct contact and cooperation between their faculty members, departments, institutes, other research centers in fields of education, research, and community services to be agreed upon and subject to the availability of funding and to the development of specific binding agreements;

WHEREAS, within the fields of study to be mutually designated, both parties desire to discuss and explore the general forms of cooperation set forth below; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out such discussions and explorations, the parties desire to set forth a framework in which such interactions may occur.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties have entered into this MOA for the purpose of setting forth their understanding and agreement with respect to the potential establishment and operation of cooperative programs.

1. Purpose of MOA

Both parties agree to encourage the following activities in particular to promote international academic cooperation:

- a. Exchange of information in education and research field of interest to both parties;
- b. Exchange of invitations to scholars for lectures, talks, and sharing of experience;
- c. Exchange of students to broaden their horizon with international experience;
- d. Exchange of teaching staff to initiate joint research depending on the specialty;

- e. Joint education, research activities, publications, and exchange of library material; and
- f. Joint community services

This Memorandum of Agreement shall be applied for both institutions. Before the implementation of these activities, both parties shall discuss the related issues for the satisfaction of each party and enter into specific activity agreements based on the forms of implementation upon mutually agreed benefit.

2. Term and Renewal

This Memorandum of Agreement shall become effective as of the date of signature by representatives of both parties and will remain in force for a period of 3 (three) years from the date of the last signature. Any amendment or termination of the Agreement shall not be effective without mutual consent in writing between the two parties. Both parties agree that this Memorandum of Agreement should be reviewed every 3 (three) years by mutual agreement, in order to evaluate progress and to improve quality of the cooperation.

3. Financial Matters

Based on this Memorandum of Agreement, both parties recognize that financial provision for the collaborative program is limited, each faculty shall endeavor to provide support in the following matter:

- a. **Faculty and staff exchanges:** It is understood that the details of joint activities, conditions for utilization of the results achieved, and arrangements for specific visits, exchanges, and all other forms of cooperation will be negotiated for each specific case. It is also understood that any financial arrangements will be negotiated in each specific case and will depend upon the availability of funds. The number of staff exchange should be mutually agreed prior to commencement of this activity.
- b. Student exchanges: The students will be required to cover all their expenses on their own; the host will only provide teaching activities. Each home institution will assist doing the administrative work and provide funding information to the students participating in the exchange. The number and length of student exchange should be mutually agreed prior to commencement of this activity. All students will be required to purchase adequate health insurance and/or accident insurance by their own for the exchange period. The study plan for the visit should be mutually agreed by both

parties.

4. Anti-Discrimination

Both parties will sign to the policy of equal opportunity and avoid any discrimination on the basis or race, age, ethnicity, religion or national origin. Faculty of Nursing, Khon Kaen University Thailand and Faculty of Nursing, University of Jember Indonesia, shall abide by these principles in the administration of this Agreement.

5. Nonbinding Terms

This MOA shall not be deemed to be a binding agreement and shall not be enforceable in any court or tribunal for any purpose.
