MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between Faculty of Nursing, Khon Kaen University-Thailand (FON-KKU) and Sekolah Tinggi Ilmu Keperawatan Muhammadiyah Pontianak (*The Nursing Institute of Muhammadiyah Pontianak*) (NIMP), West Boreno, Republic of Indonesia

Faculty of Nursing, Khon Kaen University (FON-KKU) Thailand and Sekolah Tinggi Ilmu Keperawatan Muhammadiyah Pontianak (*The Nursing Institute of Muhammadiyah Pontianak*) (NIMP) believe that mutual benefits can be derived by bridging their two Universities or Institution, achieving a closer relationship by linking their scholars, students, and personnel. Both Universities share the strong conviction that mutual understanding among people can be promoted through the establishment of academic links. Therefore, both universities agree to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding.

Article I: Principles of cooperation

FON-KKU and NIMP agree to develop their academic links under the principles of mutual understanding, mutual benefits, common interests, and mutually complementary activities. The activities will be undertaken subject to the regulation and the resources that are available at each party.

Article II: Principles of cooperation

- (1) to promote individual contacts among scholars, students, and personnel of both universities.
- (2) to promote links in teaching, research, and cultural activities.
- (3) to provide opportunities for both scholars, professors, teaching staffs, researchers and students exchanges.
- (4) to develop joint research, seminars, conferences, workshops and to encourage combined project application and publications of academic research papers.
- (5) to promote visit and investigation between FON-KKU and NIMP.
- (6) to promote the exchange of students and faculties for both academic activities and research. Tuition fees and accommodation fees for students should be waived for each party.
- (7) to encourage any other activities that both universities agree to be of mutual benefit.

Article III: Principles of cooperation

Areas of cooperation can include any academic or other programs offered by FON-KKU and NIMP.



Article IV :Principles of cooperation

It is understood and agreed that:

- (1) Student mobilization will apply to graduate/post graduate students and excellent Diploma nursing students at universities.
- (2) Financial arrangements for collaborative research, seminars, workshops, conferences, and other such activities will be negotiated separately and will be subject to the availability of funds.
- (3) The host university is not responsible to cover the costs of medical treatment for visiting scholars or students, and it is recommended that visitors obtain overseas health insurance coverage from their home country.

Details of the implementation of academic exchange, and the necessary resources for such joint activities and exchange programs shall be discussed and mutually agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of particular activity or program and will be included as an annex to this Memorandum.

Any amendment of the Memorandum will require written approval from the deans of both Parties. This Memorandum will be effective from the date of signature for a period of five (5) years.
