



Agreement of Academic Exchange and Cooperation  
between  
Khon Kaen University, Thailand  
and  
Tottori University, Japan



Khon Kaen University and of Tottori University, with the objective of promoting academic exchange and cooperation in the fields of education and research between the two universities, here agree to the following:

1. Based upon the principles of respect for each institute's independence and for mutual benefit, the two universities will engage in the following activities:
  - (1) Exchange of professors, research scholars and staff;
  - (2) Exchange of undergraduate and graduate students;
  - (3) Exchange of scientific data, samples, specimen, and other information;
  - (4) Collaborative activities such as joint research, lectures, symposia, etc;
2. In order to carry out any of the above activities, a detailed plan may be drawn up after consultation between the two universities. Such a plan shall be the result of negotiation between the parties concerned in each specific case. The parties will enter into a written agreement prior to the implementation of a specific activity.
3. This Agreement shall impose no financial obligations on either universities.
4. This Agreement remains effective for a period of five years starting from the latter date of the signing indicated below. Its period of validity may be extended by mutual agreement. Either party may, by providing six months written notice to the other party, terminate this agreement during its period of validity.
5. This Agreement is executed in two identical copies, written in English, and both parties will retain one each copy of this Agreement.

# Memorandum for Student Exchange Based on Academic Exchange

between

Khon Kaen University, Thailand

and

Tottori University, Japan



Khon Kaen University and Tottori University can exchange students within the valid period of the Agreement of Academic Exchange and Cooperation under the following conditions:

1. The host university decides the status of the students accepted.
2. The length of stay should be less than twelve months. Any longer stay must be specifically negotiated and approved between the parties.
3. A maximum of five students will be admitted for each year.
4. The home university nominates exchange students who are appropriate for the purpose of the academic exchange.
5. After considering the specialty and academic records of exchange students, the host university will determine the curriculum.
6. Each university will properly evaluate the research work done by their exchange students. The home university will credit the students based on the evaluation.
7. The host university will waive entrance fee, tuition fee and examination fee.
8. The host university has no financial obligation for living expenses, accommodation, traffic expenses nor medical treatment for the exchange students except for conditions that both parties exchange an Agreement on specific programs or admit to special treatments.
9. IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed of this Memorandum in duplicates by placing their signatures, and each party shall keep one original.

Memorandum for Student Dispatch Short-Program Based on  
Academic Exchange

between

Khon Kaen University, Thailand

and

Tottori University, Japan



Khon Kaen University and Tottori University can exchange students within the valid period of the Agreement of Academic Exchange and Cooperation under the following conditions:

1. The host university decides the status of the students accepted.
2. The length of stay should be less than two months. Any longer stay must be specifically negotiated and approved between the parties.
3. A maximum of thirty students will be admitted for each year.
4. Each party nominates exchange students appropriate for the purpose of the academic exchange.
5. After considering the specialty and academic records of exchange students, the host university will determine the curriculum.
6. Each university will properly evaluate the research work done by their exchange students. The home university will credit the students based on the evaluation.
7. The host university will waive entrance fee, tuition fee and examination fee.
8. The host university has no financial obligation for expense accruing from this program, living expenses, accommodation, traffic expenses and medical treatment for the exchange students, except for conditions that both parties exchange an Agreement on specific programs or admit to special treatments. Exchange students must have health insurance prior to the exchange.
